REASON FOR STUDY: 4 year old male with history of retinal degeneration with staring spells.  
The patient is on no medication.

TECHNICAL SUMMARY: There was a posterior dominant rhythm of 8 cps, well regulated, well sustained,

symmetrical and reactive. In the anterior head regions, there was 5 cps theta waves.

SLEEP: Stage II was recorded, characterized by steep spindles and vertex sharp transients.

PHOTIC STIMULATION: Produced no abnormalities.

HYPERVENTILATION: Was not performed.

EEG IMPRESSION: This EEG is normal awake and sleep.
